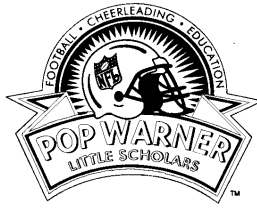

PARENTAL CONSENT AND MEDICAL AUTHORIZATION AND LIABILITY WAIVER

I/We the parents/guardians of the above named player/cheerleader on an Orange Empire Conference (OEC and HBPWF) Pop Warner Team, with this give my/our approval to his/her participation in all OEC and/or HBPWF activities during the current season. I/We assume all risks and hazards incidental to such participation, including transportation to and from such activities. I/We do knowingly waive, release, absolve, indemnify, and voluntarily agree to hold harmless: Team, Huntington Beach Pop Warner Football organization and OEC, including sponsors and other related participants, for any claim out of injury to my/our child. I/We have been warned, clearly understand, and assume the physical dangers of participating in this contact sport and/or cheerleading stunts. I/We hereby acknowledge that these dangers clearly exist and my child could be seriously and grievously injured or killed.

OEC has **secondary** excess accidental/medical group insurance coverage through the National Pop Warner Little Scholars program. This coverage is described in the flyer that I/We have been given. I/We have read the flyer and understand the provisions of the insurance provided by this program. In executing the foregoing release, I/We, the undersigned acknowledge and represent that I/We understand that any claim for injuries that arise out of my/our child's participation, must be reported to the Team or HBPWF officials **within 20 calendar days** from the date of injury via appropriate claim forms. I/We have read the foregoing release, understand it, and signed it voluntarily.

THE NAME OF OUR OWN AND/OR EMPLOYEMENT GROUP INSURANCE IS: _____

In case of injury to my/our child, whose full name and birth date are correctly listed above, I/We with this grant authority to a qualified Doctor of Medicine to render such medical treatment as said Doctor of Medicine deems necessary under the circumstances.

1. PHYSICALS: Each player and cheerleader must present evidence of a sound physical condition attested to by a duly qualified Doctor of Medicine before participating in any physical training, game, or competition. It shall be a condition of membership to provide such proof for players/cheerleaders. **Only the 2018 Pop Warner physical form will be accepted. Pop Warner will supply these forms.**

2. PROOF OF AGE: Each player and cheerleader must present legal proof of age in the form of an ORIGINAL state issued birth certificate (or the equivalent document for those born outside the United States). Photocopies are NOT acceptable. You must provide this birth certificate before the first day of practice. Please arrange now to have the proper documents available when they are requested by the HBPWF Board or team staff. It shall be a condition of membership to provide such proof for players/cheerleaders.

3. REGISTRATION FEES (DUES): Registration (Membership) fee for Tackle Football Players and Cheerleaders is as set forth on the HBPWF Financial Form. **The registration fee must be submitted with this form.** There will be a **\$25.00** service charge assessed for **ALL** returned checks, including those other than for registration. All registration fees are mandatory and are a condition of membership. (Calif. Corp. Code § 5311 & 5351) There is no guarantee expressed or implied that any specific player/cheerleader will be assigned to any specific coach, team, or division. Checks used for registrations that are returned to HBPWF for any reason shall be grounds for immediate membership termination without further notification.

4. REFUNDS: Pursuant to the California Corporations Code (Sections 5351 & 5340) once registration fees, charges, assessments, etc. are rendered to HBPWF by a member, HBPWF is under no legal obligation to provide a refund. In general, HBPWF has a policy of **NO REFUNDS**. However, from time to time the Board of Directors does consider refunds under the following conditions:

1. **ALL** refunds are subject to the approval of the HBPWF Board of Directors. **No refunds are automatic or compulsory.**
2. **ALL** refund requests must be submitted in writing to the HBPWF Board of Directors
3. All registration refund requests must be submitted within thirty (30) days of your registration (except for 4 A & C).
4. Payment by cash, check, or credit card represents a **non-refundable payment to HBPWF**.
5. No registration refund requests will be accepted on or after July 1st of the current year (except for the following):
 - A. Any player which does not make weight upon certification, cannot be placed onto a team where he can certify, and then drops from the program may be allotted up to **1/3** the amount of their registration fee.
 - B. Any player who does not make weight upon certification, and can be placed onto a team where he can certify, and then drops from the program **shall not** be entitled to any refund.
 - C. Any player or cheer which drops from the program for a valid medical reason *may* be allotted a **1/2** refund of their registration fees.

5. EQUIPMENT RESPONSIBILITY: I, as parent/guardian of said candidate, do hereby assume full and complete responsibility for the proper care and maintenance of all equipment loaned by HBPWF to said candidate, and agree to return it upon demand. I understand all equipment is to be used for HBPWF activities ONLY and that all equipment remains the legal property of HBPWF. I agree to reimburse HBPWF for any and all equipment that is lost, damaged or stolen for the full replacement cost of said equipment, with payment due when equipment is requested by HBPWF, or immediately upon the withdrawal of said candidate from HBPWF. NOTE: Players/Cheers may only use HBPWF issued equipment at practices, games, and competitions (unless as prescribed by a physician). In other words, Players/Cheers may **not** use their personal equipment or uniform.

6. REPORT CARDS – It is mandatory, and a condition of membership, to provide proof of scholastic fitness for every player and cheerleader. You may submit a copy of **all** the report cards for the school year ending June of the current year, or obtain a written document from the school (containing the school stamp thereon) indicating “Satisfactory Progress” is being achieved by your child. Those not providing said documentation may be expelled from HBPWF. Those not having a 2.0 or greater GPA, or a document indicating “Satisfactory Progress” are not eligible for post season games or cheer competition.

7. MEMBERSHIP – Your membership commences the date you properly submit the registration material to HBPWF (and HBPWF accepts it) and terminates on midnight of December 31st of the current calendar year, when you voluntarily resign, fail to provide mandatory documents when required, or when you are expelled as a result of disciplinary action. Family members enumerated on this form shall be considered members of HBPWF. Family members **not** enumerated on this form **are not** members of HBPWF. Adult members have the right to vote for the Board of Directors. **HBPWF reserves the right to refuse membership.** (Calif. Corp. Code § 5056, 5310, 5330, 5340, 5341, 5610).

8. OBLIGATIONS – It is a condition of you and your child’s membership to fulfill the obligations (dues, assessments, fees, snack bar duty, support mandatory league fundraisers, team snacks, returning of equipment, etc.) requested of you by HBPWF during your membership. This includes, but is not limited to, the already scheduled mandatory fundraiser(s).

9. GOVERNING RULES & BODY – All members of HBPWF, as a condition of their membership, are obligated to abide by the decisions of the HBPWF Board of Directors, league level administration and the following (which shall be considered incorporated in this agreement by their reference):

1. The rules, policies, and procedures set forth by Pop Warner Little Scholars, Inc.
2. The rules, policies, procedures, and decisions set forth by Orange Empire Conference, Inc.
3. The rules, policies, procedures, and by-laws set forth by Huntington Beach Pop Warner Football, Inc., Board of Directors.
4. The rules set forth by the Parent / Player HBPWF Contract.

This also includes, but is not limited to, decisions regarding placement of members on teams. This also includes, but is not limited to, decisions regarding refunds. Therefore, members have no right to refunds except as directed by the Board of Directors. Any non-compliance with rules, regulations, policies, procedures, or decisions of the aforementioned shall be cause for disciplinary action to be taken against said candidate, parent/guardian, or team by HBPWF, up to and including expulsion.

10. BY SIGNING THIS AGREEMENT YOU FOREVER WAIVE YOUR CLAIM TO ANY AND ALL MONEYS YOU GIVE, WILLGIVE, OR HAVE GIVEN, TO HBPWF IN EITHER THE PAST, PRESENT, OR FUTURE.

11. Possession or use of alcoholic beverages at any practice or game field is prohibited. Smoking is prohibited at any practice or game field.

12. CHEER COMPETITION: It is mandatory for **all players within a conference and same alma mater that has a cheer squad** to attend the conference cheer competition usually held on a Sunday in October or First Part of November. **Non attendance will result in ineligibility to play in the game following the competition.**

13. ADDITIONAL EQUIPMENT FEES: In addition to the registration fees and mandatory fundraisers there may be additional equipment fees. For players this consists of practice pants, game pants, socks, cleats, but not limited to. Cheerleaders will be required to purchase their uniform, from a league-approved vendor. “Uniform” will consist of shell, skirt, and midriff. Additional expenses include shoes, socks, bloomers, hair bows, poms, and competition fees (dependent on level and team). If new to the league, you could be asked to purchase a cheer bag and sweats (Optional).

14. AGE & WEIGHT REQUIREMENTS: Players must meet the published age and weight requirements in order to participate in HBPWF practices and games. Cheerleaders must meet the published age requirements in order to participate in HBPWF practices, games, and competitions. Such requirements are a condition of membership.

15. CONDUCT: Members whose conduct, in the opinion of HBPWF, is a danger to themselves, or others may be removed from affected activities.

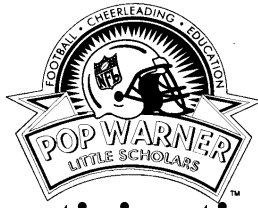
16. SEVERABILITY: Should any portion of this agreement be found invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, all remaining portions shall remain in full force and effect with as much of their original intent as legally possible. The laws of the State of California shall govern this entire agreement.

17. AMENDMENTS: Amendments may be made to this agreement **only by a written instrument**, signed by both parties.

18. NO BAILMENT ESTABLISHED FOR MEMBER'S POSSESSIONS: At no time does HBPWF guarantee the safety of your possessions. HBPWF hereby explicitly declares, and you agree, that no bailment shall ever be established for your personal possessions by HBPWF at any HBPWF activity.

19. MEDIA RELEASE: I hereby grant HBPWF or it’s designated representative the right to use my child’s picture, video, voice and/or a brief history for public viewing. The selected contents may be used in part or in whole. I understand that this material may be reproduced and disseminated as an instructional piece or for league advertising and promotion. I waive the right to inspect or approve the finished version(s) of such images including copy that may created therewith. I agree to hold HBPWF, its Board of Directors and parent volunteers harmless from all consequences of said release.

If you have more than one child participating you still are only required to volunteer 2 hours to the league snack bar. If you are a ROSTERED volunteer, this requirement is waived. You will have the option to buy out for \$40 if you choose not to volunteer for the snack bar.

Before You Sign, PLEASE READ THIS!

To insure a successful experience for everyone involved in HBPWF, it will be necessary for each parent to realize the commitment his or her child(ren) must make. Parents will be asked to get their child to EACH practice and game on time. Parents from each team will be expected to work the snack bar, bring water, snacks, or other items to games or league events on a rotating basis. Parents and children are required to support team fundraisers. There may be additional costs for items the individual teams may decide to purchase. Please check with your individual team Head Coach, Team Mom/Dad, or Cheer Mom/Dad if you have any questions regarding additional items.

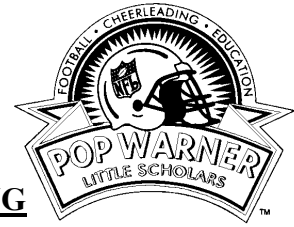

STATEMENT OF UNDERSTANDING
PLEASE READ CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING



I/We, _____, the parent(s) or legal guardians of _____, hereby acknowledge(s) that I/We have been fully advised that the purpose of this Agreement is to expressly waive my/our rights, as well as the rights of my/our child/ward listed above, as well as the rights of all heirs, spouses, siblings and/or any other possible relatives and potential claimants, and hereby agree to waive all rights associated with my child's/ward's participation in the usual, unusual, and potentially dangerous sports of tackle football, touch football, flag football, and/or cheerleading for Huntington Beach Pop Warner Football, Inc. (here after "HBPWF").

While oft times safe, on occasion injuries, serious injuries, and even death can occur in the participation in, preparation for, or in the transportation of, my child/ward to and/or from any event held by HBPWF. Although only involving children, this sporting activity carries all of the inherent risks, hazards and dangers of any adult contact sport.

I/We are aware and fully and completely understand that the type of activity that my/our child/ward will, can, could, or would be participating in for HBPWF can and in fact sometimes does, result in serious and grievous bodily injuries, including but not limited to: bumps, bruises, cuts, scrapes, sprains/strains, unconsciousness, chipped and/or broken teeth, broken bones, serious deep cuts and scars, head injuries, brain injuries, spinal injuries, vision or hearing injuries, paralyzation of all or part/portions of the body and/or death.

Further, I understand that while there is adult supervision at all HBPWF activities, there can always be accidents, injuries and mishaps, intentional or otherwise and despite that, I/We fully understand, realize, appreciate and accept the risk for such acts and waive all rights therein. I/We further understand and acknowledge in accordance with the above, that any injuries received may require treatment or a hospital visit. I/We further understand that any HBPWF activity may be conducted at a site that is remote, either by time or distance or both, from any medical help, care, treatment or hospital and nonetheless, agree to allow my/our child/ward listed above to proceed with such activities.

I/We hereby personally for my/ourselves, as well as the rights of my/our child/ward listed above, as well as all heirs, spouses, siblings and/or any other possible relatives and potential claimants, voluntarily assume all risks in connection with said activities for HBPWF for any harm, injury, or damage that may occur as a result of my/our child's/ward's participation in the sporting activities of HBPWF as noted above, whether foreseen or unforeseen, and I/We wish to enroll and sign up my/our child/ward in all HBPWF activities in spite of the known and unknown possible dangers of engaging in such sporting events and/or contact sports and noted above.

A general release does not extend to claims, which the creditor does not know or suspect to exist in his favor at the time of executing the release, which, if known by him, must have materially affected his settlement with the debtor.

and that I/We EXPRESSLY WAIVE ANY/ALL RIGHTS under the aforesaid statute.

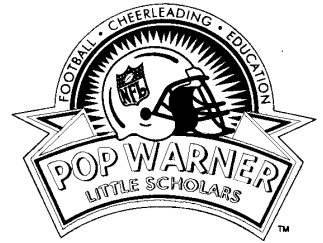

OBLIGATORY WARNING

FOOTBALL, AT ALL LEVELS, IS A CONTACT SPORT AND MAY BE DANGEROUS. MUCH EFFORT IS MADE TO MINIMIZE FOOTBALL-RELATED INJURIES. HOWEVER, YOU MUST BE MADE AWARE THAT SERIOUS INJURIES CAN OCCUR, UP TO AND INCLUDING PARALYZATION AND DEATH. ADDITIONALLY, CHEERLEADING MAY ALSO RESULT IN SERIOUS INJURIES, UP TO AND INCLUDING PARALYZATION AND DEATH, EVEN THOUGH MUCH EFFORT IS MADE TO MINIMIZE THESE INJURIES.

Members who sign up on or after August 1st might be ineligible for the first, second and/or third game of the season.

Failure to attend the scheduled Certification process on or about August 18, 2016 may delay your child's participating in games.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Question: Are registration fees and fundraisers really mandatory?

Answer: YES. According to the California Corporations Code (Section 5311 & 5351) HBPWF has the right to levy dues (Registration fees), assessments, and fees of its' members

Question: What is the refund policy of HBPWF?

Answer: Pursuant to the California Corporations Code (Sections 5351 & 5340) once registration fees, charges, A member renders assessments, etc., to HBPWF. HBPWF is under no legal obligation to provide a refund. In general, HBPWF has a policy of **NO REFUNDS** and you agree to the no refund policy when you sign up. However, from time to time the Board of Directors does consider refunds under the following conditions:

1. **All** refunds are subject to the approval of the HBPWF Board of Directors. **NO** refunds are automatic or compulsory.
2. **All** refund requests must be submitted in writing to the HBPWF Board of Directors.
3. All registration refund requests must be submitted within thirty (30) days of your registration (except for 4 A & C).
4. Payment by cash, check, or credit card represents a Non Refundable payment to HBPWF.
5. No registration refund requests will be accepted on or after June 30th (except for the following):
 - A. Any player which does not make weight upon certification, cannot be placed onto a team where he can certify, and then drops from the program may be allotted up to 1/3 the amount of their registration fees.
 - B. Any player who does not make weight upon certification and can be placed onto a team where he can certify, and then drops from the program **shall not** be entitled to any refund.
 - C. Any player or cheer which drops from the program for a valid medical reason *may* be allotted 1/2 refund of their registration fees.

Question: How long is the season?

Answer: The season begins August 1st and lasts until approx. December 15th (depending on the date of your team banquet).

Question: Where can I find the rules governing HBPWF?

Answer: Almost all the rules can be found in your "Team Book". This book is on the field at every practice and game. Included are the HBPWF By-Laws, HBPWF Policies & Procedures and OEC Administrative rules. Each football and cheer head coach is given a copy of the Pop Warner National rules and the respective CIF rulebooks for football and cheer.

Question: Are there any events on Sundays?

Answer: Yes. The OEC cheer competition is scheduled on a Sunday in October. It is mandatory for both football players and cheerleaders to attend this competition. Players who do not attend (even for religious reasons) will be subject to disciplinary action, resulting in suspension for the next scheduled game. Also, picture day could be scheduled for a Sunday.

Question: When does my membership terminate?

Answer: Your membership commences the date you properly submit the registration material to HBPWF (and HBPWF accepts it) and terminates on midnight of December 31st, when you voluntarily resign, or when you are expelled as a result of disciplinary action.

Question: When are practices held?

Answer: In the month of August, practices are Monday – Friday, from 5:30pm – 7:30pm. After Labor Day, practices are held on Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday, from 5:30pm – 7:30pm.

Question: Why do I need to give HBPWF my child's report card?

Answer: It is a Pop Warner national rule that each child provides proof of scholastic fitness. Lack of such proof renders participant ineligible for games and/or cheer competition. Further, this allows each child to participate in the scholastic portion of Pop Warner's program. Those eligible are asked to participate in regional and national awards ceremonies. Additionally, national guidelines allow HBPWF to decline an application or expel a member if a report card is not provided.

Question: Where are practices and games held?

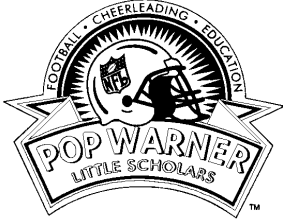
Answer: Practices are held at Edison High School and Ocean View High School. Home games are held on the EHS "Main" field and Ocean View "Stadium". "Away" games are held in cities around Orange or Los Angeles Counties (maps can be found on the OEC website).

Question: Can anyone be a Head Coach, Assistant Coach, Cheer Coach, or Assistant Cheer Coach?

Answer: No. Anyone wishing to participate in these capacities must submit an application to the Board of Directors. The Board may then conduct investigations before approving or declining an application.
